Small Group or personal study

- What was your furthest moment from God this week?
- What was your closet moment to God this week?
- Read Psalm 139:1-4 and Romans 8:26-27.
- When do you find it hardest to pray?
- What obstacles are there to you praying?
- The Psalms are the songs and prayers of God's people. When we don't know what to pray, the Psalms pray for us. Pray all of Psalm 139. Pray along with David who wrote those words. Pray them as the words saints have prayed. Pray them as your own.
- In addition to prayers from the Bible (like Psalms) that can help us pray, prayers that people have written can be helpful as well. Pray a prayer of Martin Luther below as one example of praying a faithful prayer written by one of the saints.

## *A Prayer of Martin Luther*

Behold, Lord, an empty vessel that needs to be filled. My Lord, fill it. I am weak in the faith; strengthen me. I am cold in love; warm me and make me fervent, that my love my ago out to my neighbor. I do not have a strong and firm faith; at times I doubt and am unable to trust you altogether. O Lord, help me. Strengthen my faith and trust in you.

In you I have sealed the treasure of all I have. I am poor; you are rich and came to be merciful to the poor. I am a sinner; you are upright. With me, there is an abundance of sin; in you is the fullness of righteousness. Therefore I will remain with you, of whom I can receive, but to whom I may not give.
