Small Group or personal study

- What was your furthest moment from God this week?
- What was your closet moment to God this week?
- Read Luke 15:11-32

• In this parable there are two sons who were lost. The first one who got lost returned to his father (younger son). The second one who was lost (older son outside not going into the welcome home party) has the father seek him out but we don't know if he returns to his father's home and joy, especially when that joy includes celebrating the restored younger son. The father restores the younger the son to being a son, after he would have settled for being a slave. The father sought to restore the older son to relationships of joy, peace, and acceptance of the younger son's restoration and father's welcome.

• Have you ever been lost like the younger son or known someone like the younger? What has God's restoring grace meant to you?

• Have you ever been lost like the older son and frustrated by God's forgiveness and restoration in someone else? How has it ever been difficult for you to enter into the joy of God's restoration?

• Jesus acts like the father in the parable. Jesus welcomes the lost, sinners, tax collectors and also invites the "righteous" to celebrate when sinners draw near to God. The parable invites those interested in Jesus to join in rejoicing when sinners come close to Jesus and the kingdom of God. What steps do you and our church need to take to welcome people home to be children of God, like Jesus and the father in the parable?
