Small Group or Personal Study

- Read Philippians 3:1-11.
- Take a few minutes and write down (or think about) your spiritual and religious résumé. Don't be shy because Paul did not hold back on things he had done (3:4-6). What things or activities have you found pride in that you would note?
 - What was Paul's reason for sharing his own résumé?
 - Paul didn't put his confidence in what he himself had done. Paul placed his confidence and boasting in what Jesus had done, in knowing Jesus, being found in Jesus, and knowing Jesus' power. What is the difference between (1) trusting in religious duties, accomplishments, or identity and (2) trusting in the person of Jesus Christ?
 - “Finally,” Paul wrote in 3:1, “rejoice in the Lord.” Some questions can be raised for us: (1) Where do you find your joy? (2) Do you find joy in Jesus and rejoice in Jesus? (3) How do you rejoice in the Lord?
 - The hymn “Turn Your Eyes Upon Jesus” is below. Sing or pray the hymn and take a few minutes to set your eyes on Jesus and place your trust in Christ.
