### *Small Group or Personal Study*

- Read Philippians 3:12-21.
- What goal or prize are you pressing onto in your life? What goal and prize was Paul pushing onto, even while in prison and writing to the Philippians?
- Paul encourages the Philippians to imitate him and other Christian leaders who press on in Christ and hold onto the cross and grace. Who is a Christian you would want to imitate since their life shares the hope we have in God? Who do you know who might be looking to imitate you in your life and behavior? What is the behavior you do that you would hope others would imitate?
- Paul notes there are many who live as enemies of the cross and Christ. What do you think Paul means by this, especially in light of verse 19?
- Paul stated "our citizenship is in heaven." What country are you a citizen of and what are the responsibilities, protections, and privileges of citizenship in your country? What would being a citizen of heaven now mean for you?
- How would you describe the glorious body of Jesus Christ? What was Jesus' body like and what did his body go through? Where do Christians glory most in the bodily actions of

Jesus? Paul states Jesus will transform our bodies to conform to his. What would that mean for your body?
