My Lord and my God, you see my heart and know my desires. I regret that I have for so long tried to order my own steps and live my life to please myself. Now I sincerely desire to return to you and to give myself up entirely to you. I want to be yours, and yours only, forever. Accept my offering of myself, and teach me how to make this gift beautiful and complete in your sight. Let me serve not myself but you all the days of my life.

I give you my mind; let me use it entirely to know you, your virtues, your works, and your will. I give you my will; let me seek not what pleases me, but only what pleases and honors you. Let it give me joy both to do your will and to experience whatever you have ordained for me. Let me love what you love, hate what you hate, and do exactly as you would have me do. I give you my body; let me honor you with it and keep it holy, a dwelling suitable for you, O God. I give you all my possessions; let me value them and use them only for you. Let me faithfully give back to you, through giving to the poor and needy, all that you have entrusted to me. I give you myself and my all; govern and order me and all that is mine. I give my reputation to you; may it be used to advance your honor in the world.

When I am tempted to think again like the world and to adapt to the company and customs that surround me, let me say, "I do not belong to myself; I do not serve myself, nor the world, but my God. I will give to God what belongs to God."
